
Scam Texts impersonating your Bank

Not a new scam but one that is still being used by Fraudsters, who will use this method to take over your accounts and once in, are able to take money from your account. Please remember that the banks will never send a text or email asking you to click on a link.

If you receive a suspicious text like this and are not sure then contact your bank using a trusted number, which can normally be found on the back of your bank card.

However, if you believe you have fallen victim to this scam, then contact your Bank immediately and report it to Action Fraud at www.actionfraud.police.uk or by calling 0300 123 2040.

Remember to forward any scam texts free to 7726 (SCAM).





<u>Delivery Fraud – Impersonating Hermes</u>

Kent Public protection issued an alert this week about residents being targeted with fake text messages impersonating Hermes,

about a missed delivery. This follows on from other such scams that I have reported on recently. An example of the Text message is below. Remember, never click on links contained in Text message or emails. Always remember the ABC of scam awareness and if you receive a suspicious message Never Assume or Believe it is genuine but Always Confirm by using a trusted number. Do not feel pressured, always remain in control.
