**Minutes of the Cliffsend Parish Council held in the Village Hall, Cliffsend
on 5th December 2015 at 14.30.**

1. WELCOME & APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The Chairman welcomed Members, Members of the District Council
and residents to the meeting. No apologies for absence were received.

2. MINUTES

4. MEADOW WORKING PARTY REPORT

Committee received the report of Cllr. Ms. Searles which outlined

- (i) Rospa report on Recreation Ground no action to be taken
until the report of TDC is received**
- (ii) Meadow Work and predicted costs for 2016 – Committee
noted the estimate of costings for 2016 and the schedule of
works proposed for the memorial trees, other trees and
hedge cutting which would stand referred to Council
following this meeting;**
- (iii) The outstanding lease t he views of Council to be sought;
and**
- (iv) Neighbourhood Plan – Members noted the report of Cllr.
Mrs. Hovenden that the costs of preparing the plan and the
hire of the Village Hall for public and Members meetings
would most probably be met from grants that are available.
Members were also advised that more than 50% of Village
residents had responded to the questionnaire.**

5. MEMORIAL WORKING GROUP

Cllr Alexander displayed photographs of various memorials and invited Members and residents to inspect and comment. The probable cost of the project was in the region of 15k to 20k but Cllr Alexander had discussed the proposal with a KCC councillor who had indicated that he may be able to make available some funding towards these costs.

6. PLANNING COMMITTEE

The Chairman suggested that provision should be made for the holding of 12 meetings at a cost of £84 (12 x £7.00 for each meeting.)
